Generation Innovation energises the imaginations and aspirations of young people in Northern Ireland by increasing their development of 21st-century skills and awareness of exciting future careers in innovation.

This programme will inspire and upskill participating students and will build an innovation skillset through a full immersion into the Design Thinking methodology.

The Work Experience Programme is for ambitious 17-18 year olds interested in up-skilling for the jobs of the future.

Students will receive Design Thinking training over the course of 4/5 days (depending on which location they apply to). This experience will be facilitated in person and students from across Northern Ireland will work as part of a new team, developing new ideas and communicating solutions with their peers and participating companies.

Students will use their newly acquired skills to solve a company challenge before pitching their prototype and solution back to their partner company.

This is your opportunity to spot and shape Northern Ireland's talent for the future workplace, which could even be your own.

The 2022 programme will engage with 600 students this June for an in-person event. Students will have the opportunity to work with some of the most successful and dynamic companies in Northern Ireland.
